

CONSTITUTION

Article I: Name of Organization

The name of this organization shall be _____.

Article II: Affiliations

Article III Purpose

Article IV: Members

- Section 1. Any currently registered student at PSU may become a member of this organization. Any student wishing to become a voting member of this organization may do so by providing the organization's Contact Person with their name, current mailing address, email address and/or phone number. Once this information is received, the student shall become a voting member with all the privileges and responsibilities contained therein. A student maintains member status as long as the student is registered and in good academic standing at PSU.
- Section 2. If un-unrolled persons wish to be active within the organization, they may do so in a non-voting capacity.
- Section 3. All voting members and officers of _____ must be currently enrolled students at Portland State University and pay student fees.
- Section 4. Membership shall not be denied to any student on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, sex, sexual orientation, age, marital status, disability, or veteran status.

Article V: Elections/Officers

- Section 1. Elections, officer positions, and election process may be determined by a majority vote of members present at any official meeting. Minutes must be kept according to Oregon public meeting law.
- Section 2. All officers of _____ must be currently enrolled students at Portland State University and pay student fees.
- Section 3. Officers shall not be on disciplinary probation or have a cumulative GPA below 2.5.

Article VI: Meetings

- Section 1. Meetings may be called by the President and will be held as needed.
- Section 2. Quorum consists of four members or 1/2 of total group membership, whichever is a larger number.

Article VII: Referendum, recall and impeachment procedures

Referendum, recall and impeachment procedures may be formed when a majority of the members deem it necessary.

Article VIII: Amendments

This constitution may be amended by a majority vote of all voting members. Amendments must be ratified.

Article IX: University Guidelines

Above stated student organization must abide by all SOC, SFC, and Portland State University guidelines. Student organizations are also accountable to all local, state, and federal laws.
